



Dental Benefit Providers, Inc. (DBP), a UnitedHealthcare company, is excited to introduce a new electronic payment platform called ePayment Center to accelerate and add efficiency to our claims payment process.

Through the ePayment Center, DBP will continue to offer a no-fee Automated Clearing House (ACH) delivery of claim payments with access to remittance files via download. Delivery of 835 files to clearing houses is available directly through the ePayment Center enrollment portal.

ePayment Center allows you to:

- Improve cash flow with faster primary payments and speed up secondary filing/patient collections
- Access your payment remittance remotely and securely 24/7
- Streamline reconciliation with automated payment posting capabilities
- Download remittances in various formats (835, CSV, PDF)
- Payment remittances stored securely online for 7 years

ePayment Center will be replacing Optum Pay for UnitedHealthcare Dental Plans. If you are enrolled in Optum Pay for both medical and dental payments, this transition will only impact dental payments.

To enroll, follow the steps listed below based on your current payment experience:

To register for the ePayment Center:

1. Visit uhcdental.epayment.center/registration
2. Follow the instructions to obtain a registration code
3. Your registration will be reviewed by a customer service representative and a link will be sent to your email once confirmed
4. Please note, the email will come from help@epayment.center
5. Follow the link to complete your registration and setup your account
6. Log into uhcdental.epayment.center
7. Enter your bank account information
8. Select remittance data delivery options
9. Review and accept ACH Agreement
10. Click “Submit”
11. Upon completion of the registration process, your bank account will undergo a pre-notification process to validate the account prior to commencing the electronic fund transfer delivery. This process may take up to 6 business days to complete

As an alternative to ePayment Center, you can also enroll with Zelis Payments. This alliance offers you access to multiple payers and the latest in secure electronic payment technology by accelerating and adding efficiency to today’s claims payment process.

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ePayment Center Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

What is the ePayment Center?

The ePayment center is an online portal which will allow you to enroll in electronic delivery of payments and Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA).

Some of the benefits with enrollment are:

- Improved cash flow – faster primary payments and account reconciliation
- Elimination of lockbox processing
- 24/7 secure, online access to your electronic remittance advice

Will we need to switch banks to take advantage of ePayment Center?

No. You can direct electronic claims payments to the bank of your choice.

How will we receive remittance data for posting receipts and reconciling patient accounts?

You can receive payment and remittance information via the ePayment Center. You can search, view, download and print your payments and ERA information online. You have a choice of three remittance file formats: 5010, 835, or PDF. The 835 file can be used to auto-post into your claims system. This is standard functionality and negates the need to enroll with a clearing house.

How do we enroll in ePayment Center?

Enrolling in ePayment Center is simple. You can quickly register online. We've outlined the enrollment instructions below, for your convenience.

To enroll, you'll need to have the following information available.

- 9-digit Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN) or Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Corporate name and principal information
- Bank account routing transit number (RTN) or ABA Routing Number

What is the Routing Transit Number (RTN) and where do I find it?

Your Routing Transit Number (RTN) is a 9-digit number that identifies the financial institution where the account is located. The RTN is usually located in the bottom lower left-hand corner of your check

and usually precedes your account number. It is strongly recommended that you confirm the appropriate RTN and account number with your financial institution. Incorrect entries will delay your payments. Please note that the Routing Transit Number cannot be sourced from a deposit slip.

We don't have checks for this account. Is it ok to use the information from the deposit slip instead?

No. The deposit slip contains a different RTN that will cause the payment to be rejected by your financial institution. It is strongly recommended that you confirm the appropriate RTN and account numbers with your financial institution

Can you provide access to ePayment Center for our organization's outside billing service?

Yes. You can create users with read-only access so that claim payment data can be accessed while account changes and administrative tasks remain restricted.

What does ePayment Center cost?

There is no cost for you to enroll or to receive electronic claims payments and remittance information through ePayment Center.

After we complete enrollment, when can we expect our first payment to be sent electronically?

Payments will be sent after the pre-note process is successfully completed, which typically occurs six business days after the enrollment.

Does enrollment in ePayment Center affect the way we submit claims?

No. Please continue to use your current process for all claims submissions.

If we want to begin receiving the 835 from a clearing house, what must we do to initiate the process?

You will be able to designate the clearing house to which you'd like your 835 files directed during the enrollment process on ePayment Center. By enrolling in ePayment Center, you will also be able to search, view, and download remittance data via the website.
